That we, the undersigned, having associated ourselves for the lawful purposes hereinafter stated, other than pecuniary profit, do hereby this day voluntarily associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation, pursuant to the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of California, and do hereby certify:

FIRST: That the name of this corporation is

Al Tahoe Forest Homes Association, Inc.

SECOND: That this corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

THIRD: The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed is to promote social intercourse among its members and the welfare and improvement of the area known as the Al Tahoe Government Tract in El Dorado County, California. It shall have all the general powers permitted by law and is not restricted to engage in any other lawful activity.

FOURTH: This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California.

FIFTH: The County in California where the principal office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is located is El Dorado County.
